Eliot School of Fine & Applied Arts Hosts 4th Annual Free Schoolyard Summer Concert Series

Concerts take place on select Sunday, June through August in the Eliot Schoolyard.

For the fourth year in a row, the Eliot School of Fine & Applied Arts, located at 24 Eliot Street in Jamaica Plain, will host a FREE Schoolyard Summer Concert Series. On select Sunday evenings at 5pm from June 9 – August 2, a variety of musical styles—including Jazz, Neo-Reggae, R&B, Afro-Latin, Indie Folk, Brazilian, and Hip Hop—will be performed by nine local musical groups. Performers include TrioCast, Pheonixoutthe, Man On Land, Dis N Dat Band, Pat Loomis & Friends, Debo Ray, Trinity Mei, Giuseppe Paradiso & Meridian 71, and Fabiola Mendez.

Admission to all concerts is free, but if they have the means to, patrons are asked to make a donation of \$20 or more to help pay the musicians, curators, and audio engineer. The audience is invited to bring their own seating, food, and/or beverages and settle in for an evening of sonic delight. Attendees are also asked to leave their pets at home to ensure the safety and comfort of all concertgoers.
