



CALL FOR PROPOSALS – Adult Classes & Workshops in Visual Arts & Craft for Fall 2018–Spring 2019

The Eliot School is soliciting proposals for classes and workshops in woodworking, refinishing, home repair; fiber arts, basketry, sewing & fashion; paper & book arts; drawing, comics & illustration; photography; mixed media; tinkering, repurposing & upcycling; other areas of visual art or fine craft that work within our physical space.

Propose classes or workshops of any length from 1 session to 10 weeks, to take place between September 2018 and June 2019.

The Eliot School serves the greater Boston area and beyond. Students come from around the New England area for weekly classes, and from around the country for Summer Intensives.

Class sizes range from 4–12 students. The school offers a welcoming environment with little or no homework—and limited project storage. The minimum age for an adult class is 17. We offer classes in basic, intermediate and advanced levels. Teachers have maximum flexibility within our physical limits (detailed on our website, below). We welcome your proposals.

This year we are particularly interested in expanding:

- Book and Paper workshops and classes
- Fashion and Fiber Arts workshops and classes
- Classes making a specific piece of furniture
- Classes from Boston's many immigrant traditions
- Classes held bilingually in English & Spanish or other languages
- Workshops for our Artisan's Table series
