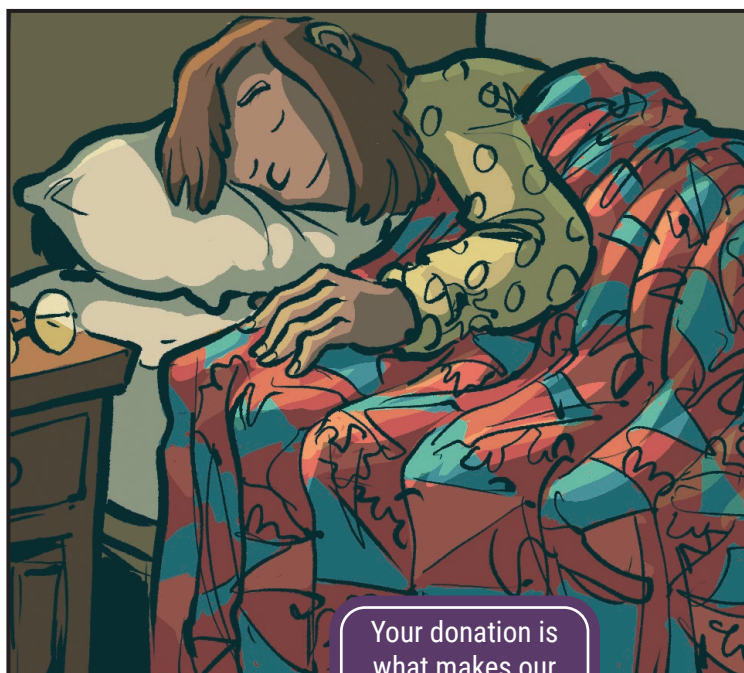
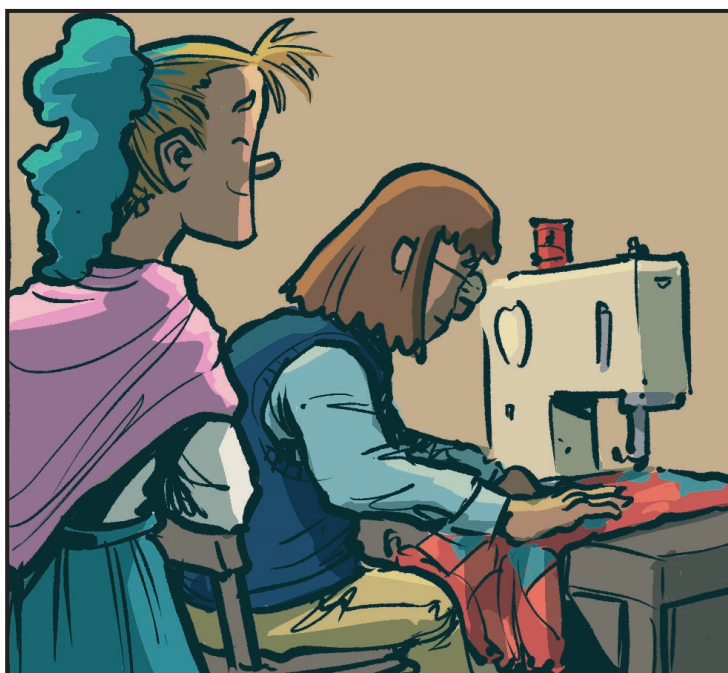
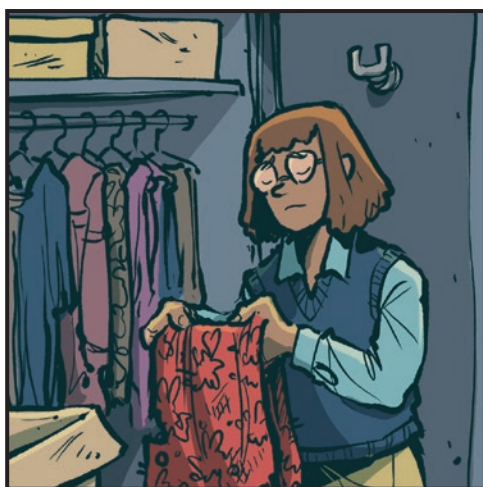
Visionary Society
